She is a founding member of AWARE. She served on at least five Executive Committees and several sub-committees, including research and advocacy on key issues. She formerly chaired the national task force 'Stop Violence Against Women!', led by the Singapore Council of Women's Organisations.

As an anthropologist, Vivienne has worked extensively on gender and development, especially in relation to culture. She taught at the National University of Singapore, The Chinese University of Hong Kong and City University of Hong Kong. She played a key role in initiating the Master's Programme in Development Studies at City University of Hong Kong and the Master's Programme in Community Leadership and Social Development at SIM University (Singapore). She is also involved in the multi-country programme "Women's empowerment and leadership development for democratization", led by Shirkat Gah Women's Resource Centre in Pakistan.
